Not to be outdone by the excitement of the show jumpers, the Summer Showcase will also offer three Hunter Derbies – one at 3' and one at 3'3", as well as a United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) rated Pony Hunter Derby.

The Summer Showcase will conclude on Sunday, August 29, with the return of the Massachusetts Hunter Jumper (MHJ) Finals. Year after year the MHJ Finals brings together the area's top equitation competitors.

Although competition will be fierce and top riders and trainers will be focused, there is always time for a little fun! The Summer Showcase will hold exhibitor parties throughout the week. Saturday, August 28, Fieldstone will feature a clam bake, which was a favorite from last year's Showcase, full of good food, great friends, and tons of fun for everyone!

"They are social events as well, which is why we are committed to making sure our exhibitors enjoy themselves both in and out of the show ring. Our nightly parties are the perfect way to kick-back and relax after a great day of showing."
