From the North or South: Rte. 3 to exit 9 (Rte. 3a, Kingston, Plymouth). Top of ramp turn north on Rte. 3A (towards Kingston). Through 2 sets of lights to a blinking light, bear left onto Rte. 27-106. Travel about 1 mile to set of lights and fork. Take left at fork onto Rte. 106. Fieldstone Farm is approximately 5 miles on the right in Halifax, MA.

From the West: Rte. 495 to Rte. 24 north. First exit Rte. 104, head east Rte. 104 merges with Rte. 106. Cross over Rte. 58 in Halifax Center. Fieldstone Farm is 1.2 miles on the left.

## Rules and Regulations

Management Reservation: Management reserves the right to:

- (1) Add to or vary the list of invited officials;
  - (2) Add or cancel a class should the best interest of the show be served;
  - (3) Decline or refuse any entry at this show without being liable;
  - (4) Eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or horse should the best interest of the show be served;
  - (5) Combine, Cancel, or reduced prize money from lack of entries. in any class.
  - (6) The Committee reserves the right to change the location of classes and to alter courses and/or fences, to change the show schedule as it deems necessary.
  - (7) The Committee reserves the right not to delay classes due to conflicts, and not to allow substitutions of classes or horses.
  - (8) If there are less than 8 horses in either section, the two sections will be combined, USEF Art. 2411 & USEF Art. 2805
- A non-member may participate as a rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent or trainer at Regular Member shows. Liabilities And Decisions: Fieldstone Horse Shows, Fieldstone Equestrian & Show facility, Scott Clawson, the Show Committee, Manager, or employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any rider, groom, attendant, animal, equipment, or spectator at the show. Should any question arise that is not provided for in the rules, that question will be referred to the Show Management, whose decision shall be final.

Entries: Complete enclosed entry form including all required U.S.E.F. numbers and signatures. A check must be attached to entry form or it will be considered a post entry. One horse per entry blank and you may copy one of the enclosed entry blanks.

Classes Scratches: entered and not scratched by using a scratch form will be charged the full class fee.

No Scratches will be allowed over the phone. You may fax in a scratch.

Total Show Scratches will not be allowed after 8 am the show day

Upon the receipt of a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian the entry fees will be refunded less a \$50.00 office processing fee. All veterinary certificates to be considered must be in the hands of show management prior to 8am the start of that show day. Refunds will be issued by mail after the show.

Post Entries will be accepted and assessed an additional charge of \$25.00 per entry.

April 10 & 11 2010 Stalls: All stabling will be permanent stalls with doors. No stalls will be reserved without full payment of the Stall Fee of \$150.00 by entry closing date. No initial bedding will be provided. If you order a stall after entry closing date the stall fee is \$175.00. Stabling fees are non refundable. In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, prior to the start of the class or Division the entry fee will be forfeited,

Refunds: except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the start of the show. The entry fees will be refunded less a \$50.00 office processing fee upon the receipt of a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian. All veterinary certificates to be considered must be in the hands of show management prior to the start of the show

Stall Splits & Hay, Grain and Shavings to be divided must be completed no later than Saturday Evening.

Feed, Hay and Bedding: We encourage you to pre-order hay,

grain & shavings on your entry blank. If you do not pre-order, a fee of \$25 will be charged for delivery. Order and payment for these items will be made to the Horse Show office. However you must open an account in the horse show office and leave an open check! Arrival: Horses may arrive in the afternoon the day before the show starts.

For earlier arrival, please call Scott Clawson (781) 254-9622.

Non-Negotiable Checks and Unpaid Balances: Will be charged \$50.00 plus a \$50.00 collection fee per month.

Dogs: Must be leashed at all times.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee.

Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); Refunds: except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the start of the show.

Warm-up: Prior to the day the show starts all horses on the grounds will be charge a \$35 grounds fee The rings will be post in the office for opening and closing times generallyly it 9 am to 4pm

Warm-ups the day of show will pay a fee per round, one round is one course. The fee is \$15.00 per course except of the derby or otherwise stated.

Minors will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions.

A valid driver's license to operate any motorized vehicle. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Horses on the grounds and not showing in any classes will be charged \$50.00 grounds fee. plus any warm up fees.

Schooling: No schooling will be permitted, at any time, in any of the show rings, except during a scheduled warm-up class. Use the Designated Schooling Areas Only. Please do not school or lunge on the grass! Poling: No Poling allowed after 8:00 AM.

Credentials & Measurement Cards: Amateur card, pony measurement cards, junior hunter measurement cards, ASPCA numbers and U.S.E.F. membership numbers must be made available to the Horse Show Secretary prior to the release of numbers. Numbers will not be issued without them.

All horses entered in Stake, Championship classes, Classics and the Grand Prix must enter in one other class in the same division. The Championship and Reserve shall be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points performing over fences in conformation and working classes. Only those horses shall receive points for ribbons won in under saddle classes. Champion and Reserve in all performance divisions. Points: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2

Office fee, add, scratch fee, MHC affiliations, insurance and a number fee of \$30 will be charged to all exhibitors.

All Prize Money: All prize money will be deducted from your entries. If a refund is due,

YOU MUST FILL OUT A REFUND FORM when closing out your entries.

Refunds & Prize money checks will be mailed no later than one week from the last day of the show. No Request for Prize money or refunds will be made after the last day of the Show you must fill out a refund form during the show.



Arena Footing: All rings are approximately 150 feet x 220 ft and are of sand footing.



